## POST - OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR TOOTH EXTRACTION(S)

## PLEASE FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AS INDICATED

- 1. Continue to bite on the gauze for the next 30 minutes.
- 2. Then remove the gauze and replace with slightly moistened gauze.
- 3. Change gauze every 30 minutes for the next 2-3 hours.
- 4. Expect some oozing for the first 24 hours.
- 5. Remove gauze when eating or drinking.
- 6. Do not spit for the next 24 hours (1day).
- 7. Do not use a straw for the next 48 hours (2 days).
- 8. Do not smoke for the next 72 hours, (3 days).

## **EXCESSIVE BLEEDING**

- 1. Wrap a tea bag in gauze and slightly moisten.
- 2. Clear the surgery area of any surface jelly like matter.
- 3. Place the moistened, wrapped tea bag directly over the bleeding area.
- 4. Bite down with firm pressure, holding for 30 minutes.
- 5. Do not open mouth to spit-out. Instead, swallow around the packing and maintain a constant pressure.
- 6. Remain quiet and repeat the above procedure if necessary.

## **SWELLING**

- 1. Swelling will reach its peak in 2-3 days.
- 2. Apply an ICE PACK to the outside of your face 20 minutes on, 20 minutes off
- 3. Most swelling goes down after 7 days.
- 4. Face discoloration may occur.

#### PAIN

- 1. The greatest pain usually occurs within the first 48 hours
- 2. Take pain medication as prescribed.
- 3. If pain increases significantly on the 4th or 5th day, contact the office.

## DIET

- 1. Drink plenty of water and other fluids (8oz. per hour while awake), for the next 48 hours.
- 2. You may eat 30 minutes to one hour after surgery.
- 3. Eat food every few hours for the first 3-4 days; milkshakes, ice cream, eggs, soups, pudding, applesauce.
- 4. Advance to a normal diet as tolerated.

#### **TOMORROW**

- Start rinsing your mouth with warm salt water (1/2 teaspoon salt to 1/2 glass of water)
   4-5 times daily.
- 2. Continue rinses for 7-10 days.
- 3. Also, rinse with Peridex oral rinse twice a day for 30 seconds, continue for 14 days.
